Rob Genest adds gold to Irish Masters medal collection

46 swimmers took to the water in the London Aquatics centre for day 3 of the individual events – 200m butterfly, 50m backstroke, 100m breaststroke and 400m freestyle (men only). LEN and the competition organisers appear to have taken some of the feedback on board from angry and frustrated competitors from the first two days as there was a significant improvement in communication to swimmers though social media and at the facility by day 3.

9 hardy souls, otherwise known as lunatics, were up early in the morning for the 200m butterfly. The event is a test of endurance, mental strength and determination and all rose to the challenge. There were top 10 finishes for Helena Mc Grath (40-44) and Agnieszka Wysocka-Khan (30-34) and a new Irish record for Agnieszka.

Moving swiftly on to the 50m backstroke there was disappointment for Liz Cosgrave as she was placed 4th in 55-59 age group who despite winning her heat was placed behind a swimmer with a slower time. A challenge is currently in with LEN so watch this space.

In the 100m breaststroke there were strong performances from the women and delight for Deirdre Morris who got her hands on a silver medal in the 45-49 age group and a new Irish record. Nell Mc Carthy (60-64) and Claire O'Connell (25-29) also set new Irish records and finished inside the top 20.

Rob Genest continues to dominate in the freestyle events, adding gold to his 2 silver medals and another Irish record. Rob has finished his swimming for this competition and should be delighted with his performances over the last 3 days.

The relays got under way shortly after 7.30pm and looked set to run late in to the night. Ireland was well represented with teams from Aer Lingus Masters, Hibernian, NAC Masters and City of Derry. The Aer Lingus Masters (240-279) team of Vivian Mongey, Peter Conway, Patricia Reilly and Claire O'Dwyer set the bar high as the first team up, winning a bronze medal in a time of 2.21.60 which is a new Irish record. The 160-199 Aer Lingus team followed shortly to finish in 6th place and a new Irish record of 2.01.33.

The medal haul now stands at 12; 1 individual gold, 6 individual silver, 3 individual bronze and 2 relay bronze.

Day 4 schedule includes 200m backstroke, 50m butterfly, 100m freestyle, 400m freestyle (women only) and 4x50m mixed freestyle.
